

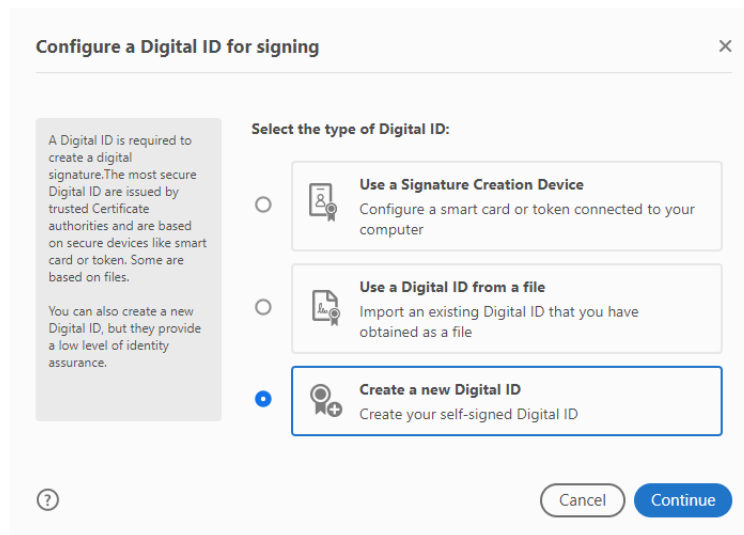
Instructions for Digital Signature

Once you have completed the form, please insert your digital signature. Click on the "Applicant's Signature" field on the last page of the form and use your Digital ID to sign the application form. **Once you have signed, the document may be locked for further editing.** Please ensure that you have accurately filled out all necessary information before placing your digital signature on the form.

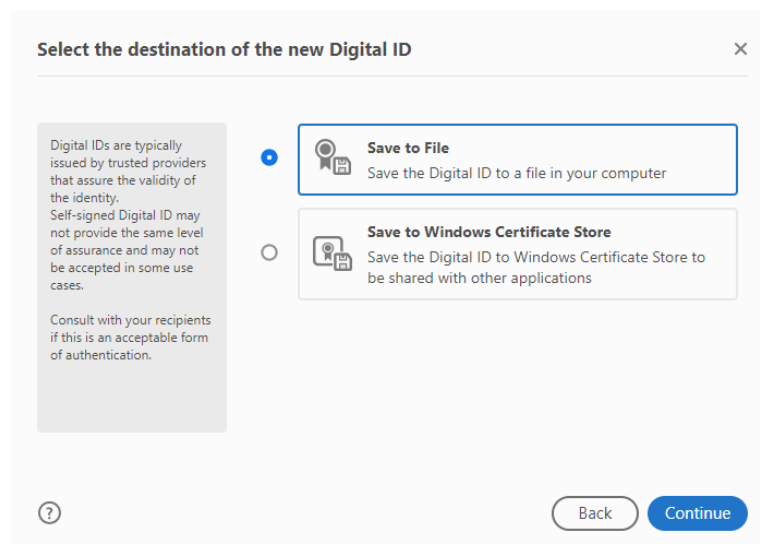


You can configure a Digital ID for signing by creating a new Digital ID:

(i) Select "Create a new Digital ID", then press "Continue".



(ii) When prompted, select the destination of the new Digital ID as "Save to File". Click "Continue" to proceed.



(iii) Input the required identity information to create the self-signed Digital ID, then press "Continue".
